THE PARENT'S CODE OF ETHICS

Athlete:

The Club does not require that parents attend a comprehensive orientation program, but we do require that all parents of participating players sign a Parent's Code of Ethics form to pledge their cooperation as follows:

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for youth - not for adults.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can do, such as being a respectful fan or providing transportation.
- I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach, and that the coach up holds the Coaches' Code of Ethics.
